## 2021 is off to a great start!

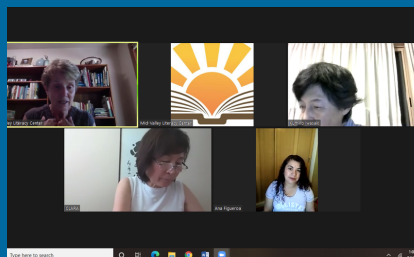

On January 14th, Hector Ponce received his US Citizenship! Congratulations Hector, we are so proud of you!



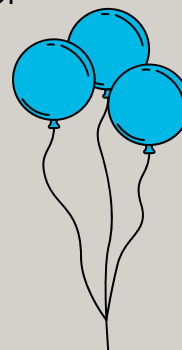
